Your letter of yesterday's date to hand and contents noted.

For your information the Steam Yacht "SURF" is at present laid up with only a watchman on board. She is lying off the Island of Skiathos which is some considerable distance from the nearest mainland port - Piraeus, and difficult to reach, there being no regular communication. In addition, should a Surveyor be sent there he would find no conveniences if he were delayed.

The vessel has now been laid up for a considerable time, but when she is eventually put into commission again her first port of call will be Piraeus and arrangements will then be made with your local Surveyor to carry out the inspection for Boiler Survey.

This is all the information we can give you, and no doubt you will appreciate the difficulties causing the delay.
