I have to inform you that I am in receipt of a telegram from the Society's Surveyors at Southampton, stating that the classification certificates of the Twin Screw Motor Yacht "SONA", recently completed by Messrs. Camper & Nicholsons Ltd., are urgently required.

In accordance with the usual practice all the fees for the surveys of the hull and machinery must be paid before the classification certificates can be issued, and as your engines Nos. 251 and 252 of the Semi-Diesel type have been fitted into this vessel and the fees amounting to £57-10-4 for which an account was sent you on the 5th May last are still unpaid, the issue of the classification certificates is being delayed.

I enclose a statement of account and shall be obliged by your favouring me with a remittance in settlement.
