With reference to the London First Entry Report No. 85486 on the Engines Nos. 251/2 built by Messrs. Vickers-Petters Ltd., of Ipswich, for Messrs. Camper & Nicholson's M/V No. 307, I have to inform you that I am advised that the installation on board of this machinery is to be carried out by Messrs. Camper & Nicholson and consequently the proportion of the fee for this work will be chargeable to them.

An account has been rendered to Messrs. Vickers-Petters for the fee for the survey during construction at their Works, being four-fifths of the total amount, viz:- £57:10:4, and you will therefore be good enough to collect the balance, viz:- £14:7:8, on completion of the vessel.
