Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 18th instant respecting Messrs. Sulzer's Engines Nos. 6033 & 6039 now being fitted in Messrs. Camper & Nicholsons' Yard No. 363, and in reply I have to acquaint you that the fees charged by the Winterthur Surveyors are in accordance with the agreement between the Engine Builders and this Society.

The Surveyors' charges do not include the survey during installation of the machinery, and in the present instance a fee of  $\frac{1}{5}$ th of the special survey in accordance with the scale should be charged by you to the Yacht Builders, viz:-  $\frac{1}{5}$ th of £71. 5. 0. = £14. 3. 0.
