VESSEL'S NAME "DALE CASTLE" REPORT Liv. No. 125344

The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

This trawler was released from Government Service 6.46.

The LIVERPOOL Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock and a PERIODICAL SPECIAL SURVEY (D) commenced. As a result of the examination it was found that very extensive repairs and renewals would be required.

In view of the above and lack of repair facilities it was decided not to proceed with the Survey and at a later date the Owners advised the Surveyors the vessel had been sold and broken up. Letter of confirmation from the Owners is attached.

The Liverpool Committee have transmitted the case for the consideration of the Committee.

It is accordingly submitted the ~~status~~ <sup>name & character</sup> of the vessel be withdrawn from the Register Book.
