Ltd. attend at their Works in Bradford on the 18th December 1942, in order to examine and test one horizontal, single stage, feed water heater No. 335, together with bye-pass Valve and drain box, intended for Messrs. Amos & Smith Ltd. Engine No. 718.

The tubes and headers of the feed water heater and the bye-pass valve were hydraulically tested to 500 lbs per square inch, and the body of the feed water heater and the drain box were hydraulically tested to 80 lbs. per square inch, with satisfactory results.

Materials and workmanship are considered satisfactory.
