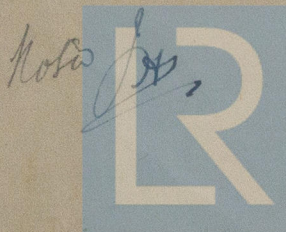
In February, 1947, repairs were carried out to the  
margin plate and a tank margin bracket in Nos. 1 and  
2 holds on account of leakage, *from double bottom*

During a heavy storm on 4th April, 1947, a leak  
developed in No. 2 hold. The ship listed and subsequently  
sank. Water broke out of the hold and flooded the  
engine room. *Vessel loaded with deck cargo of pig props*

There were 10 survivors.
