

Extracts from Mr. W. Ronald's Journal.

Friday, 24th May, 1946.

Object of Survey - General Examination.

Vessel lying afloat at Tyne Dock Engineering Co. Ltd.

'With Superintendent and Mr. McCallum examined holds, recommended some bulkhead corner brackets be renewed, also four frames (port side) in aft hold to renew.

Decks examined and recommended test holes be drilled as considered necessary, hatch coamings examined and recommended parts be doubled, midship shell (port side) above main sheer examined and recommended four plates be renewed and one part doubled. Survey to continue'.

Monday, 27th May, 1946.

Object of Survey - General Examination.

Vessel lying afloat at Tyne Dock Engineering Co. Ltd.

'With Superintendent and Mr. McCallum, examined poop side shell (starboard side) and found plating holed and wasted. Recommended one plate be doubled'.

Monday, 3rd June, 1946.

Object of Survey - General Examination.

Vessel drydocked at Tyne Dock Engineering Co. Ltd.

'In company with Mr. McCallum examined work in progress on repairs and renewals.

Recommended one poop side plate starboard side to renew. Casing top in way of gratings to renew.

Port side of No. 2 hatch to renew.'
