

S.S. "ADAPTITY"
Messrs. Fellows & Co's Yard No. 337

This vessel was constructed recently at Yarmouth by the above mentioned Builders, then taken to Goole and lengthened by 21 feet, and was afterwards brought back to Messrs. Fellows' Yard for installation of machinery and completion.

A letter has been received from the Hull Surveyors asking what fee should be charged for their services in connexion with the lengthening.

This vessel before being lengthened was a sister to the "AQUEITY", No. 88340 in the Register Book, the gross tonnage of which is 301. In view of the lengthening the gross tonnage of the "ADAPTITY" will be greater than 301, and the fee for Special Survey during construction based on this extra tonnage will be correspondingly increased.

(when the Special Survey fees have been paid)
It is therefore submitted/the Hull Surveyors might be credited with the difference between the Special Survey fee that would have been charged on the vessel as originally built (i.e. the amount of the hull fee charged in the case of the "AQUEITY") and the amount of the Special Survey fee which will now be chargeable after the lengthening.
