Nature of Survey .....


The S.S. No.1 became due 7.30 and a proposal to carry out same within the year of grace has been agreed to.

The Newcastle Surveyors now report the S.S. No.1 has been partly held by the examination of the bottom and rudder in dry dock.

Fractures in No.2 double bottom tank margins have been repaired by electric welding, additional gussets fitted and some rivets renewed in the top bar of the centre keelson. *BOTTOM COATED.*

The anchors have been converted to the Trojan bolted type and retested.

It is submitted action be deferred.



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
