
With reference to your letter of the 8th instant and print P.81 showing Alarm Gear for Oil Fuel Settling Tanks received with same, we note it is considered that a greater margin than 5% of the capacity of the settling tanks should be left as overflow space.

We have discussed this question with Owners and they suggest to meet the above, that the alarm gear should be arranged to operate at 93% full instead of 95%.


We shall be glad to hear in due course that this meets with your approval.
