I duly received your letter of the 26th ultimo, with enclosures advised therein, and have to acquaint you that the plan of alarm device for the oil fuel settling tanks of the above vessels will be approved, provided the gear be fitted and tested to the satisfaction of the Surveyors.

It is noted that the alarm gear will operate when each settling tank is 95% full, and it is suggested that a greater margin than 5% of the capacity of the settling tank should be left as overflow space, in view of the large size of the filling mains to the oil fuel bunkers.

The attention of the Surveyors should be drawn to this point and I shall be glad if they will discuss the matter with the Owners' Representative and Messrs. Cammell Laird & Co.

Two copies of the plan referred to above are returned herewith.
