I return herewith two copies of the plans forwarded with your letter of the 3rd instant in connexion with s.s. "ALMEDA STAR" and have to acquaint you that ^{this} plan showing proposed modifications to the Pumping Arrangement will be approved, provided the arrangements be as shown and amended thereon and the remaining requirements of Sections 20 and 34 of the Rules (1934-5) be complied with so far as they are applicable.

It is noted that some of the existing sounding pipes to the insulated holds are now marked 2" diameter, but I have to point out that, as shown on the originally approved plan, these are 2½" diameter.

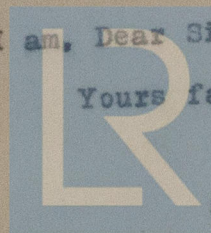
It is concluded that when the oil fuel tanks are being filled, one of the deep tanks between frames Nos. 86 and 91 will be used as an overflow tank and I shall be glad if the Surveyors will state whether this deep tank is fitted with an alarm device.
