I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant enclosing plans (in triplicate) showing scantlings of additional pillars and girders at aft end and amidship, and at fore end, in the steamers "ALMEDA STAR" and "ANDALUCIA STAR", and with regard thereto I have the pleasure to state that the arrangements as shown and amended on the plan of after end and amidship pillars and girders will be approved, provided they be carried out to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.

With regard to the plan of fore end pillars and girders, I have to request that you will be so good as to forward a plan showing new deck widths at fore end, so that this plan may be dealt with.

Two copies of the plan of pillars and girders at aft end and amidship are enclosed, the third copy being retained for reference.
