I beg to submit for the consideration of the Committee, plans in triplicate of Crank, Thrust and Propeller Shafts, proposed by Messrs. David Rowan & Co., Ltd., for the above Contracts.

The main engine particulars are stated to be as follows:-

Cylinders - $18\frac{1}{2}$ " - 31" - 52" x 39" stroke.
Boiler pressure - 200 lbs. per square inch.

The Shafting diameters will be made as follows:-

Crank Shaft..... $10\frac{1}{2}$ " diam.
Thrust Shaft (Single Collar)..... $10\frac{1}{8}$ " diam.
Propeller Shaft (with continuous liner)... 12" diam.

No Intermediate Shaft.

The Propeller will be of cast iron, 15'-3" diam.
