Reverting to your letter of the 15th ultimo and to previous correspondence respecting the case of the ex-German steamer "FRITZ", which has been under survey at your port for condition and Special Survey No.1, for the purpose of obtaining the Society's classification, I have to inform you that a report has now been received from Glasgow, from which it appears that repairs consequent upon damage sustained have been carried out, and that the Special Survey has been completed.

In view of the fact that your reports on Forms 8 & 9 have not yet been received the following telegram was sent you yesterday which is hereby confirmed, viz:-
