With reference to your request of yesterday's date to be furnished with condition and damage reports, if any, issued in the case of the ex-German Motor Ship "FRITZ", I have to acquaint you that no reports have yet come to hand from the Society's Surveyors at Leith of the survey held by them on the vessel whilst at their port, and in the circumstances, I accordingly telegraphed to them this afternoon, as follows, viz:-

"how case stands."

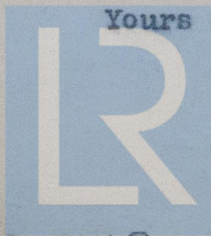
