Messrs. Tatuuma Kisen Kabushiki Kaisha, the Owners of the above vessel, have informed me that she struck a reef and sank in deep water on the 10th instant at Goto Island, near Japan.

At the time of the casualty she was on a voyage from the Philippine Islands to Yokohama, carrying a full cargo of iron ore.

She has not yet been officially declared as a total loss but I understand the possibilities of salvage are very slight.
