With reference to your accounts which we have received for the "AVELONA STAR" dated the 19th and 27th May, we should be glad if you would go over these as we feel that the charges made are high.

Some time ago, while the work was being carried out, we applied to you for an approximate figure for fees, and at that time you gave us the sum of £110. Although we felt that this was a high figure, we did not challenge it at the time, particularly as we were only asking for the figure for the purpose of estimating the ultimate cost of the work. We are, however, now faced with an additional £10. 10/- for the machinery alterations.
