

This boiler was examined internally and externally by the Society's Surveyors at this port in December 1930/January 1931 in connexion with the Special Survey No. 1 of the vessel, when it was reported that the same was found in good condition and its safety valves were afterwards adjusted under steam to 204 lbs per square inch.
