Sir,

T.S.S. "AVELONA STAR" - No.14910 in the Register Book.

I am desired by Mr. Dickerson to transmit herewith a plan shewing the proposed new deckhouse to be fitted on the original promenade deck of the above vessel. The plan has been examined and the plating and stiffening are considered to be somewhat less than the Society's standard for a deckhouse of this size and in this position and, in view of the fact that the material was ordered prior to the submission of the plan and has already been delivered, the case is forwarded to your Office for consideration.

Mr. Dickerson desires me to suggest that the stiffeners might be accepted of the size proposed, provided they be attached at their lower ends to the deck plating by means of lugs, but he will be glad to receive instructions as to the minimum thickness of plating which could be approved.

The particulars of the principal alterations to be carried out to this vessel were contained in the copy of/
