T.S.S. "AVELONA STAR" - Proposed arrangement of
Oil Fuel Tanks at Sides of
Tunnel.

With reference to your letter of today's
date and to the call at this Office of your Representative in
regard to the above tanks I have to inform you that, if the
overflow pipes from the tanks at the sides of the tunnel be
arranged so that the maximum pressure to which the tanks might
be subjected, will not exceed that for which they were originally
designed, no increase to the scantlings will be necessary if oil
fuel be carried in these tanks.

It is understood from your Representative
that a plan shewing the oil fuel pumping arrangements has been
submitted to the Society's Surveyors at Greenock.
