I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of yesterday's date respecting the Steamer "ASPASIA",

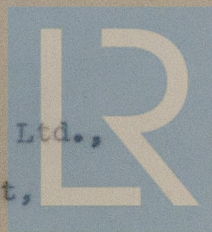
