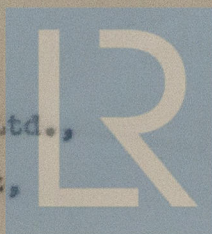
With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the Steamer "ASPASIA", I beg to acquaint you that the 2nd Special Survey No.3, which became due on this vessel at the end of June last year, has been partly held, and in view of the fact that the Year of Grace for the completion of this inspection will expire at the end of the present month, I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know what arrangements are proposed to be made for this matter to receive attention.

I think it well to add that in February last the Society's Surveyors at Hull recommended that two stoppered stay tubes in the port boiler should be renewed before the end of May 1940, and I shall be glad if you will let me know what arrangements are proposed to be made for this to be done.
