Reverting to your letter of the 18th January last respecting the steamer "ASPASIA", I beg to acquaint you the Committee have now had before them the report of survey recently held by the Society's Surveyors at Hull. The Surveyors report that the vessel has been placed in drydock and in view of the examination which has been made, the Committee are agreeable to the completion of the second Special Survey No.3 being postponed for the present, provided it be carried out before the expiration of the year of grace in June next.

The Boiler Survey has also been carried out and in view of the fact that two stay tubes in the port boiler are fitted with stoppers, the class has been continued subject to these stay tubes being renewed before the end of May next.
