
With reference to your letter of the 17th instant, respecting the classification certificate issued for the machinery of the steamer "ROWANPARK", I beg to acquaint you that I have been in further communication with the Society's Office at Glasgow and that in reply the Surveyors maintain that their statement regarding the leakage at the front end bottom seams of both main boilers is quite correct.

I have further to explain that it would be quite contrary to the practice of the Committee of this Society to issue a clean certificate in any case in which there still remain some repairs to be carried out, even though they may be of a slight character, and I regret that I am unable to comply with your request for a clear certificate until the requisite work has been done and a satisfactory report received from the Society's Surveyors.
