Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 7th instant with reference to the classification certificate issued for the Machinery and Boilers of the new Steamer "DUNANPARK", and to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Dundee and Glasgow are being communicated with in the matter at once, and upon receipt of their reply I shall have the pleasure of again writing to you.

I may, however, remark that from the official report which has been received from the Surveyors, it appears that on trials some leakage was observed on the bottom of front end of both boilers, and that it was arranged that this would be overhauled and made good on the Steamer's return in three or four weeks. As the period mentioned has now expired, I conclude that the Steamer will again come under inspection, and as soon as the necessary overhauling has taken place and a satisfactory report is received, the restriction at present appearing on the certificate will at once be removed.
