with reference to the case of the Steamer "Laverock" built 1909 at Troon, and the Owners Letter regarding same. I would respectfully suggest that the Owners should be informed that the state of the rivetted work of the ballast tanks was carefully examined while under water pressure and before any cement was applied to the surfaces, and the workmanship was found sound and good.

The subsequent cementing of the bilges and margin plates of the ballast tanks was carried out entirely in accordance with the requirements of the owners, which is the general and recognised practice.
