and in their hands until the present date.

We have secured employment for her which will enable us  
to start her on or about 1st November next and our object in writing  
to request that after examination of the vessel by your Surveyors,  
subsequent periodical surveys shall be treated as becoming due 4,  
12 years respectively from the date of such examination.

We would also request that in the circumstances the  
examination of the vessel in drydock be dispensed with, in view of the  
fact that the boat is just as she was launched.
