BORE VIII. — Helsinki, Mar. 1.— Finnish steamer Bore VIII., bound Emden, reported stranded near Borkum. Crew saved but steamer supposed to have become a wreck.

Rome, Feb. 28.—Finnish steamer Bore VIII. has gone down near Heligoland while on her way from Sweden to a German North Sea port, states a Helsinki message. The crew escaped unhurt.—Reuter.


