THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the owners, United States War Shipping Administration attend the S/S "SWEEP" Official Number 218904 of New York at Galveston, Texas on the 22nd day of March, 1944, for the purpose of inspecting (a) protection of openings, (b) guard rails, (c) freeing ports, (d) means of access to crew's quarters, and found same to have been maintained in an effective condition; also, that no alterations had been made to hull or superstructures which would affect the calculations determining the position of the load lines.

The International also Coastwise Load Line Certificates have now been endorsed in accordance with the Regulations of the Commandant, United States Coast Guard.

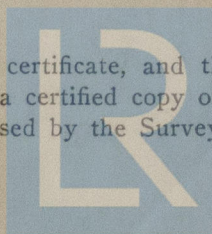
