THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of War Shipping Administration

attend the S.S. "SWEEP" (ex "CLEAN") Official Number 218904

of New York at Baltimore, Md.

on the 10th day of April 1943, for the purpose of inspecting (a) protection of openings, (b) guard rails, (c) freeing ports, (d) means of access to crew's quarters, and found same to have been maintained in an effective condition; also, that no alterations had been made to hull or superstructures which would affect the calculations determining the position of the load lines.

In accordance with the Regulations of the Commandant, United States Coast Guard, the Renewal Survey is now complete.

The Special Survey 2nd No. 3 is now being completed and the notation of S. S. 2nd No. 3-4,43 will be recommended to the Committee.


