Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 17th instant intimating that on the arrival of the steamer "ORAC" at a United Kingdom Port, the Boiler Survey will be dealt with, and if possible the intermediate wheel for the windlass will be examined or renewed.

Your remarks in regard to the Second Special Survey No.2 have been carefully noted, and I have to say that, provided the vessel be generally examined and her condition favourably reported upon by the Society's Surveyors, the Committee will not object to the inspection in question being postponed until some time within the Year of Grace allowed by the Society's Rules, i.e. by the end of July 1941.
