The Intermediate driving wheel of the windlass, which somewhat worn, requires to be specially examined at the Special Survey.

The Owners' Agents recently wrote that this vessel was due Sierra Leone, and was expected home towards the end of October.

The Owners' Agents subsequently wrote that the vessel had arrived at Liverpool, but they had no knowledge as to where she had discharge. (*Schaller*)

The Owners' Consulting Engineers now write that as soon as the vessel arrives in a U.K. port the Boiler Survey will receive attention, but that it is probable that owing to Board of Trade restrictions it will not be possible to carry out the 2nd Special Survey No.2, and they suggest that a general examination should be made with a view to postponing the inspection until a more suitable date. They add that the intermediate wheel for the windlass will have to be examined or renewed if possible.
