

With reference to the First Entry Reports being forwarded to-day on the Steamer "BEECHPARK", I beg to draw your attention to the memorandum attached to the hull report from which you will observe that a fee of £18:16/10 is chargeable to the Admiralty in this case in respect of the survey of the hull as a Standard Vessel, which fees should, on payment, be credited to the Greenock office.

With regard to the report on the Boilers, I have on several occasions communicated with Messrs. Wm. Denny & Bros. Ltd., but they do not admit any liability for fees, as they state that the same are payable by the Ministry of Shipping.

As the boilers were completed in this district as Standard boilers and the relative instalment certificates were signed, <sup>3</sup>16ths of the machinery fee is chargeable for the inspection of the same, and on a gross tonnage of 5135 this would amount to £21:8/-. 28-10-7

In the circumstances, I shall be glad to be informed whether you will collect this amount from the Admiralty, or
