
With reference to the preliminary letter dated the 2nd January last, addressed to your Sydney Office by the Society's Surveyors at that port, regarding the condition of the lower casing of the H.P. turbine of the steamer "ORFORD", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have now had the case under consideration, and that they have confirmed the recommendation of the Surveyors that the vessel's class should be continued subject to this part being again examined before the end of January 1941.

I would take this opportunity to remind you that the Annual Boiler Survey became due in November last and it will be appreciated if you will kindly let me know what arrangements are proposed to be made for this inspection to be held; also for the Special Survey No.3 which becomes due at the end of this month, to be carried out.
