

T.S.S. "NAPIER STAR"

Plans of alterations to this vessel have been dealt with, and on the 1st instant Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson stated that it was proposed to lengthen the vessel by 30 feet on the waterline, and they were informed that, retaining the present draught, no increase to the scantlings would be required, but it would be necessary for the equipment to be made equivalent to letter G, as in the previous proposal.

Plans of new Maier bow (in duplicate) have been handed in by Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson's representative, the actual lengthening on the waterline being now 24'6".

It is submitted that provided the arrangements be carried out as shown and amended on the plans, and to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors, the same will merit approval.
