Dear Sirs,

With reference to the telephone conversation which took place respecting the proposal to fit a new bow of Maier form to the T.S.S. "NAPIER STAR", which would lengthen her on the waterline by about 30 feet, the wells being filled in as in the previous proposal, I have to inform you that the scantlings of the vessel have been examined for this increased length, and it is found that, retaining the present draught, no increase to the scantlings would be required, but it would be necessary for the equipment to be made equivalent to letter g<sup>+</sup>, as in the previous proposal.
