M. I beg to return herewith two copies of each of the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 11th instant, shewing proposals for filling in the forward and after wells of the T.S.S. "NAPIER STAR", and with regard thereto I have pleasure in stating that provided the arrangements be carried out as shewn and amended on the plans and to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors, the same will be approved.

The scantlings and arrangements have been considered on the assumption that no increase in draught is required on account of the fitting of these extra erections.

The equipment will not be affected by these alterations.

The case has been discussed in this Office with your Representative, and, as requested by him, I have wired you to-day as follows :-

"Napierstar shelter deck beams no hanging cargo through  
"beams eight threeandhalf threeandhalf point fourtwo web  
"fivetwo flange channel half beams point threefour web  
"fivetwo flange channel".

The remaining copy of each of the plans in question is being retained for reference.
