Dear Sirs,

With reference to our letter and enclosures of yesterday's date, in connection with proposed structural alterations to T.S.S. "Napier Star", and in particular respecting conversion of non-watertight stokehold bulkhead to watertight bulkhead, we are now in receipt of a sketch from the Owners shewing the means adopted in a sister ship, the T.S.S. "Stuart Star". In this vessel the stokehold bulkhead at 96/98 frames was removed altogether and the watertight bulkhead at 103 frame transferred to this position. We are accordingly now proceeding on these lines.

In order to save you time in examining our proposals we wired to-day as follows :-

"Reference our yesterdays submissions Napier Star now propose transfer watertight bulkhead 103 as in Stuart Star cancel consideration our plan stokehold bulkhead."
