We regret to say that owing to the unfortunate turn of events at about the time the last survey was held, our records in these matters are very incomplete. Nevertheless, we are now cabling and writing to the Master of this vessel, which is at present abroad, and hope to have from him, in a very short time, information as to whether the cylinder jacket has since been renewed, or failing this, whether the temporary repair is still holding good. In the latter case, however, we shall endeavour to have the jacket renewed at the earliest possible date and will keep you fully advised.
