I have to confirm the following telegram which was sent to you to-day respecting the Steamer "OLYMPIER", Glasgow First Entry report No. 40166, viz:-

"OLYMPIER REPORT 40166 Owners anxious obtain classification certificate without midship section please collect fees and telegraph when paid".


