It is submitted the Surveyor be requested to state definitely if all the requirements of the Sixth Survey, except the drilling of the outside plating, have been carried out to his satisfaction, also, if the state of the plating is in his opinion such, that the owners proposal to defer the drilling of the same until the subsequent First Survey (which would become due in four years time) may merit the approval of the Committee, without any drilling whatever being done at the present time.

The Surveyor should state definitely whether the Owners desire the machinery to be classed if so he should forward plans of the boilers with the present scantlings marked thereon by the Surveyor after he has made a careful examination of them, he should also forward particulars & sizes of the cylinders & all shafts on a first class form, the dimensions to be ascertained from actual measurements by the Surveyor. His report should be forwarded to this Office.
