Sir

I am in a certain difficulty with regard to the survey I have held on the Steamer "Delfin" ex Optic - This vessel has undergone extensive alterations and at first I was called in only to survey the said alterations - and this work not being a Special Survey I assumed did not come under the conditions of Circular No 1074. Now however that the repairs have been completed the owners wish the Survey to be reckoned as 6th survey ^{see} in 1910 and they also wish the Machinery & boilers (which I have seen during the repairs) to be under Survey -

The difficulties I find are -

- 1st. Not knowing that the Survey was to be a Special periodical Survey - I did not obtain the Committee's consent to hold it.
- 2nd If the Committee kindly consent to waive the above objection there is the fact that the plates were not drilled as required by rule - I may state that all the plating is in excellent surface condition both inside and out -
