H. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4th instant respecting the Special Survey No. 1 which became due in May, 1902 on your Iron Bk. "EURYDICE", and having submitted the same to the Committee at their meeting today, I have to state that, as intimated in my letter of the 6th February, arrangements should be made to have the survey held abroad at an early date as the vessel is not coming home from the River Plate.

I enclose a list of ports at which the Society has Surveyors stationed, and I have to suggest that you should give instructions for the survey to be held at Cape Town, to which port the vessel appears to be proceeding.
