Nature of Survey

S.S. No. 2

The S.S. No. 2 has now been held, and the following repairs done (due to wear & tear):— *Shee fitted to stem, one bow plate and rudder plating repaired, fore-castle deck renewed, pumps repaired, and minor repairs.*

The poop deck has been temporarily repaired by sheathing, and it is proposed to postpone the permanent repairs until the vessel's arrival at a home port. The Surveyor considers the deck as repaired for another twelve months.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain classed *100A1*

with record of Survey *1.99* and notation of S.S. *Cal*
