Special Survey No.2 due November,1896.

In December last, the Owners drew attention to the fact that the vessel underwent considerable damage repairs at Delagoa Bay in January,1896, and since then, she had been trading abroad so that they had had no opportunity to hold the survey. She was at that time engaged on a voyage which would last about 6 months, and they craved the Committee's indulgence to allow the matter to stand over till the vessel's return. They now write she is at present on passage from Puget Sound to East London, and they cannot state definitely as to her future destination, and they crave a further indulgence of the Committee until she reaches a home port.
