Nature of Survey

S.S. Rep.

Repairs due to wear and tear, and fitting new boilers:—
boiler bearers, part awning deck, and part main deck renewed: minor
repairs effected.

S.S.No.1 due 4, 94 was held in September, 1893, with the
exception of the repainting of the patent asphalt ~~and~~ ⁱⁿ the coal
bunkers ~~in~~ ^{and} the after hold. The Committee ^{then} decided that the S.S.No.1
should not be recorded until the asphalt was repaired.

The Surveyor reports that the asphalt in the
machinery spaces and coal bunkers has ^{now} been repaired, but the asphalt
in the holds still remain to be repaired, and in his opinion this can
safely be left until the vessel is dry docked in about 5 or 6 months
time.

The year of grace allowed by the Rules expires at the
end of April next.

It is submitted, in view of the small portion ^{that} ~~of what~~
remains to complete the S.S.No.1, the Owners proposal to defer the same
until the vessel is next placed in dry dock, merits the favourable
consideration of the Committee, the vessel ^{appears eligible to remain} ~~is~~ classed "A" "Awning deck
with freeboard" with record of survey 2, 95 Bdx. and notation of S.S. Bdx.
No. 1-93, per Bordeaux report No. 700, as recommended, subject to the
asphalt being repaired when next the vessel is placed in dry dock.
