The Second Periodical Survey on this vessel became due in July last.

The Owners stated in reply to notice, in June last, respecting the Boiler survey, that their Steamers were altogether employed around the Indian Coasts, and never came to this Country, and were under the survey of the Society's Surveyors in India.

The Calcutta Surveyor was accordingly informed of the Periodical Survey being due, and was requested to give the case the necessary attention.

The Surveyor states that the vessel is now in port, and the Marine Superintendent has requested him to commence the survey at once, but it will have to be done piece by piece, while the vessel is running, and she will not go into dry dock until May next. He will, however, have the survey carried out with as little delay as possible.

It is submitted the Surveyor should be requested to use every endeavour to complete the survey as soon as possible, in view of its being ~~so much~~ overdue, and in the meantime, the vessel's class might be allowed to remain undisturbed.

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
