We Monoruddeen Manjee an inhabitant
of Mysapore in Zillah Twentyfour Pergunnahs but now residing
in Calcutta and Lall Mohomed Dandee an
inhabitant of Mysapore aforesaid but now residing in Calcutta
do respectively affirm and declare as follows.

And I the said Monoruddeen for myself say

1 I am the Head Manjee and steersman of Captain
William Stewarts bark or boat and I the said Lall Mohomed
for myself say that I am one of the Dandies or Caremen of the
same boat.

2 We know the Caledonia Dock at Sulta on the Howrah
side of the River Hooghly We remember taking Captain Stewart
there about a month ago to see a vessel which was in the
Dock. We do not know her name she was undocked about
thirty three or thirty four days ago. We also remember taking
Captain Stewart to the same Dock twice during the ten or
twelve days which preceded the last mentioned visit. On each
occasion Captain Stewart went into the Dock. I the said
Monoruddeen remained with the boat at the Pier head of the
Dock and did not see what Captain Stewart did inside the
Dock. I the said Lall Mohomed accompanied Captain Stewart
into the Dock. On his first visit he went down under the
vessel walking round it in the dock examined her bottom
and sides and on the second occasion he also went up the
ladder into the vessel.

These last mentioned visits were made in the morning
between five and six O'clock. We saw no one stirring about
the Caledonia Dock. We know the Commercial Dock and
